THIS MONTH IN PRESCHOOL, WE WILL FOCUS ON:

THEMES, HOLIDAYS & EVENTS (CULTURE, HISTORY & SOCIAL SCIENCES)

THEMES: Harvest, Friendship, Stone Soup, Farms

HOLIDAYS: Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving

EVENTS: Farm Fieldtrip, Stone Soup Day

LANGUAGE & LITERACY

LETTERS OF THE MONTH: Gg, Hh, Ii

INTEREST IN LITERACY: Extend a story

COMPREHENSION: Use prior knowledge to gain understanding, identify main events

PRINT: Pictures convey meaning; PK- Locate and identify pictures

PHONICS: Identify soft and loud sounds, copy and create sounds; PK- letter sounds *e* and *f*

LETTERS & WORDS: Recognize letters in own name; PK- Recognize Ee & Ff

WRITING: Make marks to represent events, draw a vertical line; PK- Write letters in standard format - Ee, Ff
